K-TAG BLUE DENATURING AGENT

Product Description and Purpose

K-TAG BLUE is a concentrated, liquid denaturing agent for use on condemned carcasses in meat, poultry and rabbit processing plants. Spraying of the condemned carcasses with a solution of **K-TAG BLUE** imparts to the carcasses a blue color.

General Usage Directions

Prepare a dilution of 4 fluid ounces **K-TAG BLUE** to 1 gallon of water (1:32). Using a suitable low-pressure sprayer, apply this solution to condemned carcasses of animals in meat, poultry and rabbit processing plants. Follow USDA Regulations, Paragraph 314.2, tanking and denaturing condemned carcasses and parts (USDA Manual of Meat Inspection).

Physical Properties

Concentrated, viscous, dark blue liquid. Mixes with water in all proportions to yield clear, blue solutions. Its solutions are moderately foaming and have neutral pHs (8.0-10.0). Has a specific gravity from 1.0-1.03. Because of its complete water solubility, **K-TAG BLUE** and its solutions are readily rinsed from non-porous surfaces.

Caution
